Statement 6 of 2008

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Elected Body

Background

Sub-section 10(1) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995* provides for the ACT Remuneration Tribunal (the Tribunal) to inquire into, and determine the remuneration, allowances and other entitlements of the holders of any position or appointment notified in writing to the Tribunal by the Chief Minister.

The Chief Minister has referred the positions of Chair, Deputy Chair and Members of the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Elected Body to the Tribunal for such determination.

Tribunal Consideration

The Committee is a statutory body established under the *Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Elected Body Act 2008*, and the functions are to represent Aboriginal people and Torres Strait Islanders and act as an advocate for their interests, and advise the Minister on issues of concern to them.

It is considered that the Body is an advisory one with a similar level of responsibility as other bodies that are classified at Group 2, Level 1 – ‘Significant advisory bodies and other bodies advising Government on key strategic matters AND/OR operating significant Government programs’.

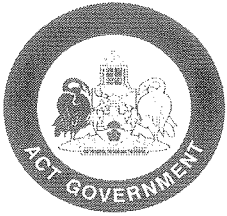
Tribunal Determination

The Tribunal has determined that the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Elected Body be classified as Group 2, Level 1, and that remuneration be set at \$19,100 per annum for the Chair and \$11,460 per annum for Deputy Chair and Members with effect from 5 June 2008.

The remuneration level for the position of Chair shall be paid to the Deputy Chair or a Member who is required to act as the Chair when the Chair cannot exercise the function.

The Tribunal decided that the Determination will take effect on 5 June 2008, the date of referral by the acting Chief Minister.

Under sub-section 10(1) of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995* the Remuneration Tribunal has inquired into the remuneration, allowances and other entitlements to be paid to the Members of the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Elected Body.

The Tribunal has determined as follows:

1. That Attachment 1 of Determination 22 of 2007 made in November 2007 be varied by inserting the following in Group 2, Level 1: -

2. Economy class travel for the purposes of Clause 4, and 3 or 3.5 star accommodation for the purposes of Clause 6 of Determination 16 of 2007 – ‘Travel allowances for full-time and part-time holders of public office’; and
3. Determination 16 of 2007 is varied by inserting Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Elected Body, Chair, Deputy Chair and Members in the Schedule under Part-Time Public Offices.

This Determination shall take effect on 5 June 2008.
